He maintains an overall 3.78 GPA while taking advanced calculus, English and physics classes. Hughes is a member of the varsity swim and dive team, serving as captain in the 2020-21 season and receiving most improved and most valuable player awards.

He is a chapter officer for SkillsUSA and received a Bronze medal in the 2021 district competition for electrical construction wiring. Following graduation, Ryan's goal is to become a member of the local IBEW 103 union.
