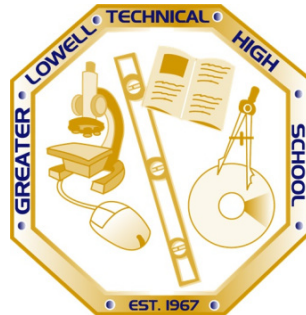
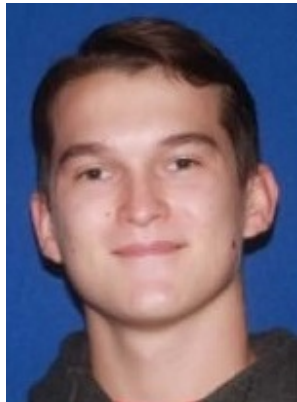


# Four REACH for the stars at Greater Lowell Tech
