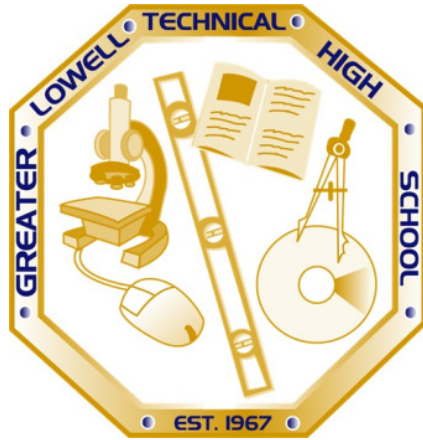


Ry, Leo, Silva, Chartier get November nod at Greater Lowell Tech

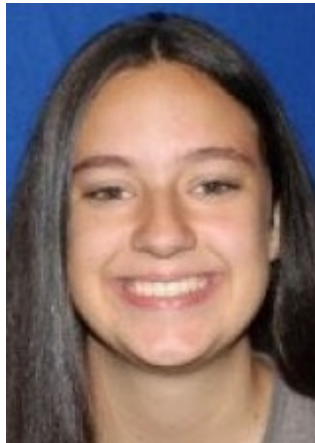
