Gabriel competes for the soccer and spring track teams. He is looking forward to attending college and gaining additional real-world experience in the HVAC field.

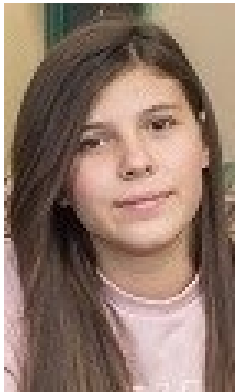
