TYNGSBORO – Greater Lowell Technical High School has selected its October Students of the Month, based on the characteristics of respect, effort, accountability, commitment and honesty.

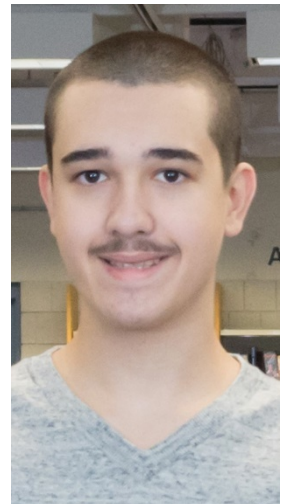
