

# GL Tech exits playoffs with a first-round loss

TYNGSBORO -- Greater Lowell Tech was held scoreless in the second half and lost to visiting Arlington Catholic, 29-8, in a Division 6 North quarterfinal football matchup on Saturday.

The fourth-seeded Gryphons dropped to 5-3, while No. 5 Arlington Catholic (5-3) is moving on to play top-seeded Hamilton-Wenham in the semifinals.

Senior quarterback Trevor Lupien scored on a 4-yard run and then found RJ Sawtelle for the 2-point conversion to give GLT a brief 8-7 lead in the second quarter. But the Gryphons were outscored, 22-0, from that point on.

Lupien had a strong performance in the loss with 82 rushing yards on 17 carries and 114 yards passing. Juan Serrano had 11 carries for 82 yards and five receptions for 56 yards.

Arlington Catholic got three touchdown runs from Joshua Smith and a TD pass from Michael Burke to Kendall Parrish.

Greater Lowell outgained AC, 279-267, and ran more plays than AC (48-38).
