TYNGSBORO -- Greater Lowell Tech is the top basketball team among state vocational schools -- again.

The Gryphons captured their fourth straight State Vocational Large School championship on Saturday night with a tight, 67-64, win over Assabet Valley. GL has also won four straight CAC titles.

Sophomore Luis Mota scored 21 points for the winners, including sinking two clutch free throws with three seconds left in the game to provide for the winning margin. Mota also had 7 rebounds.

Sophomore Luis Huertas and Paul Choate both pitched in with 14 points on the night. Choate corraled 11 rebounds. Senior Ian Kirumira had 8 points and 14 boards.

Greater Lowell Tech, 18-4 overall, will open play in the MIAA Tournament at home on Thursday night.
