Greater Lowell Technical High School Freshman Exploratory Necessities



Many of Greater Lowell's technical programs require certain clothing or safety items in order for students to fully participate. Below is a list of our technical programs and the necessary items they require for freshmen students to participate fully in their exploratory classes. **Clothing must be appropriate for basic safety.** *All freshman students are provided with a pair of safety glasses at the beginning of the exploratory period. Additional pairs of safety glasses can be purchased at the school in the mall stores.*

Auto Collision Repair - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Automotive Technology - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

C.A.D.D. - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Carpentry - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Cosmetology - Long pants (no pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Culinary Arts - Long pants (no pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>. Students with long fingernails must wear food service gloves (provided by school). Eyelash extensions are not allowed.

Design and Visual - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Early Childhood Education - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Electrical - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Electronics - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Engineering - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Graphics - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Health Assisting - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Hospitality - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

HVAC/R - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Machine Technology - safety glasses, no hooded sweatshirts or loose clothing, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Marketing - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Masonry - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Medical Assisting - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.

Metal Fabrication - safety glasses, no hooded sweatshirts or loose clothing, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Painting & Design - safety glasses, long pants (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Plumbing - safety glasses, long pants - jeans/denim preferred (no sweat pants or pants with rips), work boots or sneakers <u>only</u>.

Programming & Web Design - No personal protective equipment/clothing requirements.
