Dear Mr. Byrne:

On August 3, 2006, a duly designated representative of the Massachusetts Division of Occupational Safety (DOS) and the U.S. EPA reviewed the records of the Greater Lowell Technical High School to ensure compliance and implementation of 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 763 Subpart E - Asbestos Containing Materials in Schools (ASHERA).

At the time of the inspection, the management plan was complete, with records to indicate that the plan had been updated on a regular basis, including three year reinspections and response action records.

To ensure that the Greater Lowell Technical High School remains in compliance with the ASHERA regulation, continue the present course of action, updating the management plan with dated copies of annual notifications and six month surveillance. The school's written policy regarding the disturbance of asbestos panels by shop teachers and/or students should continue to be posted and enforced. DOS is available to provide an informational seminar to the school and school personnel on this matter, should the need arise.
