
Kindly provide us with the following information:

1. The identity of the Owner's Project Manager (OPM) for the construction project at the High School
2. A copy of the containment procedures for the construction project, developed in accordance with regulations of the Mass. School Building Authority, 963 CMR 2.04 (2). The containment procedures are supposed to be implemented as part of the construction project, and must be consistent with the Sheet Metal and Air Conditioning Contractors' National Association (SMACNA) *IAQ Guidelines for Occupied Buildings Under Construction*.
3. A schedule for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year for "office hours" for the construction project, or a description of whatever mechanism is currently in place to allow people in the occupied part of the building to ask questions or raise concerns about construction-related conditions
4. The test results, field notes and any chain-of-custody documentation for UEC's report dated 9/5/14. The test results are summarized in the report – the GLTO is requesting the actual test results.
5. All post-abatement air clearance test results for asbestos abatement work done during the course of the construction project, and a request that you continue to receive any future results

This request is being made in accordance with the provisions of MGL Chapter 150 E.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this request. It is greatly appreciated.
