## LEADERSHIP, SERVICE, SCHOLARSHIP AND CHARACTER

#### **LEADERSHIP:**

The student who exercises leadership:

- -Proposes new solutions and ideas
- -Demonstrates leadership in promoting school activities
- -Exercises influence on peers in upholding school ideals
- -Contributes ideas that improve the life of the school
- -Exemplifies positive attitudes
- -Inspires positive behavior in others
- -Demonstrates academic initiative
- -Successfully holds school offices or positions of responsibility
- -Conducts business efficiently and effectively, and without prodding
- -Demonstrates reliability and dependability
- -Demonstrates leadership in the classroom, at work, and in school or community activities
- -Is thoroughly dependable in any responsibility accepted

### **SERVICE:**

The student who serves:

- -Participates in some outside activity: Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, church groups; volunteers service for children, the aged, poor, or disadvantaged; family duties
- -Volunteers assistance, is gladly available
- -Works well with others and takes on difficult or inconspicuous responsibilities
- -Cheerfully and enthusiastically renders any requested service to the school
- -Represents the class or school in inter-class and inter-scholastic competition
- -Does committee and group work uncomplainingly
- -Shows courtesy by assisting visitors, teachers, and students

### **SCHOLARSHIP:**

The student who shows strong scholarship:

- -Always completes assignments thoroughly
- -Participates in class discussions/answers and asks questions
- -Displays an interest in and love for learning new concepts and information
- -Is prepared for tests and presentations
- -Strives to do their best, not just to do enough to get by
- -Demonstrates the ability to work independently/find information on their own

### CHARACTER:

- -Meets promptly responsibilities to school and teacher
- -Demonstrates highest standards of honesty and reliability
- -Exemplifies desirable qualities of personality (cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, stability)
- -Cooperates by complying with school regulations
- -Upholds principles of morality and ethics.
- -Remains positive, even when given difficult assignments or when his/her team is losing.
