
Hosting a Conference in Canvas

1. Open a course within Canvas and click Conferences.




2. Click + Conference






4. When you are ready to host your Conference, click Start

5. Select Microphone. Your laptop will ask for permission to use the microphone, click Allow.




6. You will be asked to perform a quick audio test. If you can hear yourself, click the green thumbs up. If you do not hear your echo, click no & check your sound preferences.



8. Within BigBlueButton there are several features: User Options




