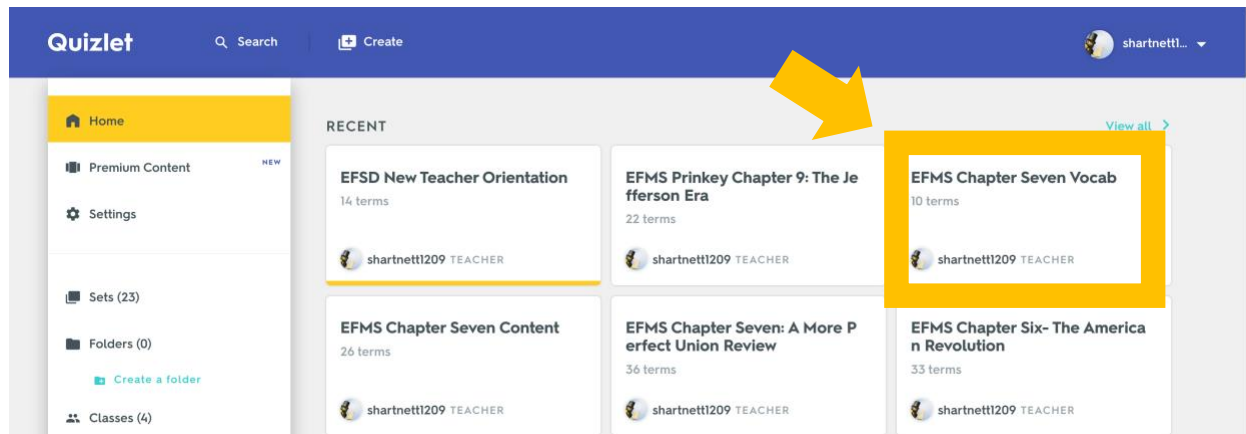


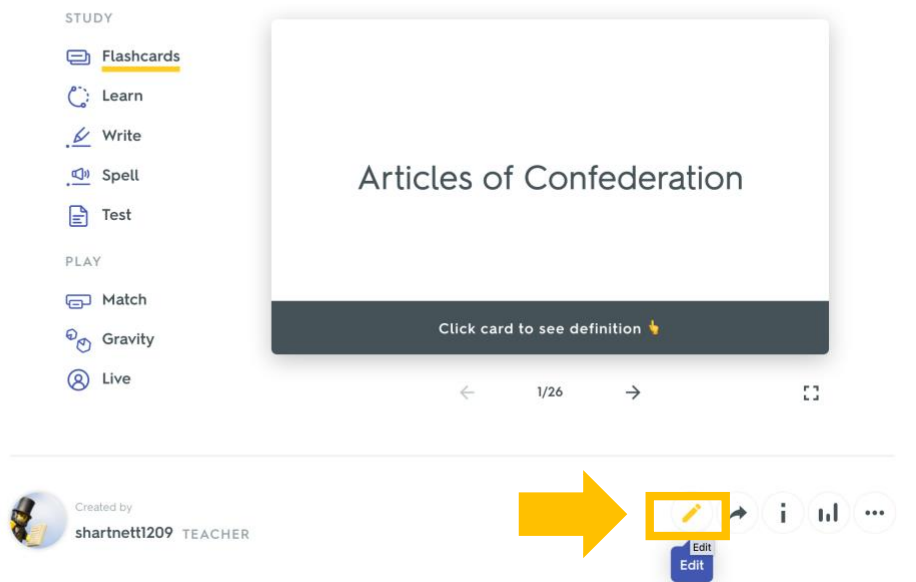
# Adding a Quizlet Set to a Module

1. Open Quizlet.com & click on a study set that you would like to include within Canvas.

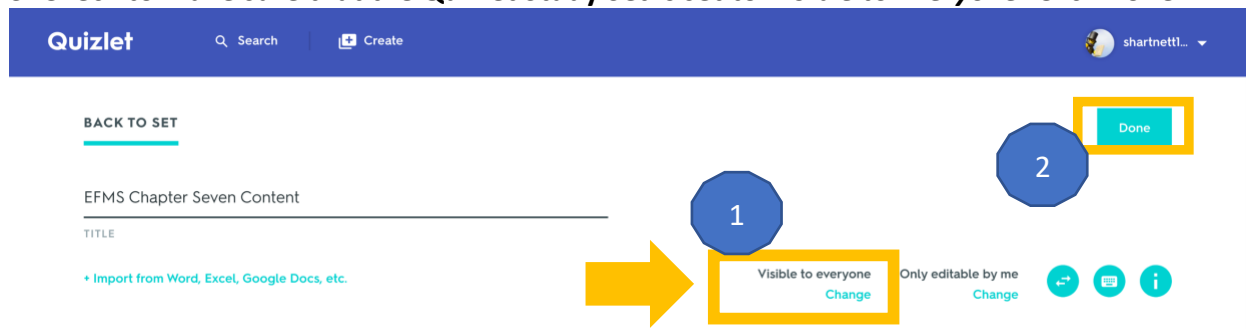


2. Click the *Pencil (Edit)* icon




3. Check to make sure that the Quizlet Study Set is set to *Visible to Everyone*. Click Done.




