NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

SMOKE FREE ENVIRONMENT

In accordance with law and to promote the health and safety of all students and staff, the District prohibits all employees, students and patrons from smoking or using tobacco products in all school facilities. The following rules shall apply to all facilities operated by the Board of Education. As used here, “smoke” or “smoking” shall mean the lighting or carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or similar device including vapor products (electronic nicotine delivery system).

1. No smoking shall be permitted on school property.
2. Students are not permitted to smoke in any school district facility or on school grounds at any time, nor while under school supervision away from the school facilities, nor while on a school bus.
