BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

MATERIALS/SERVICES FEES, CHARGES

In accordance with CT General Statutes' requirement to provide a free public school education, the Board of Education will provide at no cost to students all instructional equipment, books and materials as it deems necessary, needed to maintain the desired instructional program subject to reasonable rules concerning their care and use.

Students shall be charged for damaged or lost textbooks, Library/Media materials and other equipment or materials. Fines and assessments shall be levied, collected and disbursed subject to regulation by the building Principal. The schools are authorized to withhold transcripts, grades, diplomas, or report cards until payment or return of lost item is made.
