BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND REPORTING

The practice of safety shall be considered a facet of the instructional plan of the district schools by virtue of educational programs in traffic and pedestrian safety, bus safety, fire prevention, emergency procedures, etc., appropriately geared to students at different grade levels.

The building administrator shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school. General areas of emphasis shall include, but not be limited to: in-service training; accident record-keeping; plant inspection; vehicle safety programs; fire prevention; and emergency procedures and traffic safety problems relevant to students, employees and the community.
