Salem School, in compliance with OSHA instructions, will promote safe medical practices by implementing a written Exposure Control Plan and a schedule of how and when the Plan will be implemented. This Plan will provide an opportunity to receive Hepatitis B vaccine as recommended by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service in “Guidelines for Protecting the Safety and Health of Health Care Workers”, 1988 Publication.

Salem School will also provide appropriate training to its employees on a yearly basis, at no cost to the employee, as described in Salem School’s Exposure Control Plan.

The written Exposure Control Plan is accessible to all school health services employees (school nurse, school health aides and first aid providers). The plan will be updated annually, if changes in protocol or procedure require it. The Plan will be located in the **ORANGE FOLDER** in the school health office.

The Salem School nurse has been designated to be the compliance manager and will be responsible for implementing this plan.
