SCHOOL SECURITY AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

The Board of Education shall establish at each school a School Security and Safety Committee to increase staff and student awareness of safety and health issues and to review the adequacy of emergency response procedures at each school in the District. The committee shall be responsible for assisting in the development of the school's security and safety plan for the school and administering such plan.

The Board believes the involvement of key community stakeholders is central to success in developing and implementing a comprehensive emergency readiness plan. Membership in the committee must include a local law enforcement officer, a local first responder (fire department), a teacher, an administrator, a mental health professional, a parent/guardian of an enrolled student and any other persons the Board finds necessary. The collaborating team shall access need and develop the school security and safety plan/emergency management plan and assist in its implantation and review.

It is critical that the District, when developing a plan to prepare for, prevent, respond to and recover from incidents, regardless of cause, size or complexity, understand and utilize in a school emergency situation the consistent approach embodied in the National Incident Management System (NIMS) offered by the US Department of Homeland Security. Also the school security and safety plan for each school shall be based upon the school security and safety plan standards developed by the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection.
