BUS CONDUCT

School transportation privileges are extended to students conditional upon their satisfactory behavior on the bus.

Students will be advised that they may be suspended from transportation services for unsatisfactory conduct while awaiting or receiving transportation to and from school, which endangers persons or property or violate a Board policy or administrative regulation. In addition, such unsatisfactory conduct may lead to the initiation of expulsion procedures.
