VANDALISM

The Board of Education believes that it is the right of every student to be educated in a clean and well-maintained facility. Vandalism, graffiti and defacement of school property are an impediment to education and will not be tolerated.

Any student accused of causing damage to school property will be subject to discipline in accordance with school discipline policies and procedures. If found guilty of willfully causing damage, the student and or his or her parents will be required to follow the behavioral plan agreed upon at the hearing. This plan may include suspension, expulsion, and/or payment for any repairs to the damaged items.
