MARRIED/PREGNANT STUDENTS

Married students shall have the same educational opportunities as unmarried students. The Board of Education is responsible for the education of all school-age children.

A pregnant girl may remain in her regular school program as long as her physical and emotional condition permits. Any variation from a pregnant student's continuance in regular classes shall be based upon her specific needs. Homebound and hospitalized instruction to a pregnant student or student having given birth when a physician has certified that homebound and hospitalized instruction is in the child's best interest and should continue for a specific amount of time.

A student who is under age 18 and a mother may request permission from the Board to attend adult education class in lieu of the regular school program.
