## BY LAWS OF THE BOARD

## AD HOC COMMITTEES

The chairperson of the Board of Education shall, with the consent of the Board, appoint temporary and special committees as may be deemed necessary or advisable and the chairperson shall be an ex officio member of each committee.

The committee shall be charged with its purpose at the time of appointment and the committee shall be dissolved when its final report has been made to the Board. The same rules shall apply to special committees as apply to standing committees.

All such committees shall follow the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act as required by statute.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Chairperson of the Board may be appointed to serve as a full/voting member of an ad hoc committee, as long as there is no more than 4 full/voting members of any ad hoc committee.
