BY LAWS OF THE BOARD

ELECTION OF MEMBERS

The Board of Education shall consist of nine members, three of whom shall be elected at each biennial town election for a term of six years.

New members of the Board shall be sworn into office by the Salem Town Clerk within 14 days after election and before entering upon official duties.

The terms of office shall commence the second Tuesday following the election.

The terms of office of all elected Town officials expires when the term for the newly elected officials commence.
