BY LAWS OF THE BOARD

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

At the first meeting after the newly elected members are seated, the Board of Education shall elect one of its members as chairperson, one as vice-chairperson, one as secretary, and one as treasurer by majority vote. Other than the Chairperson, members may occupy more than one office. The votes of each member shall be recorded in the minutes of that meeting and made available for public inspection within 48 hours.
