BY LAWS OF THE BOARD

FILLING VACANCIES

Member vacancy:

Any vacancy occurring on the Board of Education shall be filled by a candidate, elected by a majority vote of the remaining members of the Board, to serve until the next regular (biennial) election. Such vacancies will be formally announced to the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting and the election to fill the vacancy shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

Office vacancy:

In the event of an office vacancy, the office shall be filled at the first regular meeting after all membership vacancies, if any, have been filled.
