VI. BOARD PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Board President, Mr. Charles Kenny, commented on the following:

Radio Disney visited Ravine Drive School as the reward for reading over 57,000 books during the Read Across America contest. Thanked the PTO who made a donation of \$3,200 for document cameras and \$2,600 for iPads.

Township of Aberdeen Mayor Fred Tagliarini and Matawan Borough Mayor Paul Buccellato made their Personal Best Week proclamations.

VII. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Welcomed parents, mayors, administrators and students.

Addressed the Ravine Drive "Read Across America" event which was the highlight of this month.

Recognized the Ravine Drive PTO members for their generous donations. They raised a total of \$5,800 for iPads and document cameras. Ms. Todaro and Ms. Rosenberg from the PTO were honored.

Dr. Kaplan received a certificate of appreciation and has been honored with the Princeton University Distinguished Teacher Award.

A donation of \$500 each to three organizations was made. Donations came from collections made by the District during autism week. Ms. Tellini, representing the Parents of Autistic Children, Ms. Cassigrande and Ms. Porter from the Parents of Special People and Mike Chiavolino from Autisim Speaks each received \$500 checks on behalf of their organizations.

Mr. Jakubowski recognized Ms. Hromyak for her dedication and hard work during Autism Week.

Mr. Healy, Ms. Zitarosa and Dr. Sheard updated the Board on the Language Arts Literacy program through a power point presentation.

VIII. STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT

The student representative to the Board, Matthew Tomasello, made the following statements:

Ravine Drive Elementary School hosted a Radio Disney show. The first grades are immersed in a poetry unit.

At Lloyd Road Elementary School, students took the NJASK exam. The students also went to Medieval Times and are preparing for their concert and band recitals.

Second and Third grade students at Cliffwood Elementary School took the NJPASS and NJASK exams respectively. They also prepared works of art for Personal Best Week and are getting ready for their Barnes and Noble nights.

Strathmore Elementary School students preformed their musical at the High School. The students also participated in an anti-bullying event and their fun day. On May 23rd, the school will hold its art show.

The Middle School will hold a reception to show their art work while there will be an orientation for incoming sixth grade students.

Cast members of the High School spring musical received nominations from the Count Basie Theater for their performances. Upcoming events include the spring band and choir concert, senior picnic and the prom.

X. CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

It was moved by Ms. Esposito, seconded by Dr. Larchuk and approved by a unanimous roll call vote to approve the following Curriculum and Instruction Agenda items:

The Superintendent recommends:

A. TRAVEL

1. Pursuant to travel policy #4033, the following staff is approved for travel related to training and seminars. This travel is deemed educationally necessary and fiscally prudent, and all travel expenditures shall be directly related to and within the scope of the staff member's current responsibilities and the district's Professional Development Plan. (**Curriculum & Instruction Attachment #1**)

Policy: 4033 Travel/Reimbursable Expenses

Rationale: Required estimates to abide by law and policy.

B. OTHER

1. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education approve the waiver request for the Bilingual Education Program to be submitted to the Department of Education Office of Title 1.

Rationale: Each year the school district must apply for a waiver in regards to a Bilingual Program. We are not able to offer a full-time Bilingual Education Program as required by law, and meet the criteria for an alternative program. We must request a waiver for a Bilingual Instructional Program alternative for the 2012-2013 school year. Instructional Program alternatives include, but are not limited to, the Bilingual part-time component; the Bilingual Resource Program; the Bilingual Tutorial; the Sheltered English Instruction Program; and the High-Intensity ESL Program.

2. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education approve the submission of the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District's 2012-2013 Professional Development Plan to the Monmouth County Professional Development Board for review and approval.

3. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District approve the following Co-curricular Organization for the 2012-2013 school year:

- English Honor Society, High School

Rationale: To promote literature and English throughout the High School and to recognize the reward the high achievement of our top performing English students.

Cost: \$165.00 registration fee for the Society

4. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education approve Ms. Karen Parisi to work with the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District in the writing of curriculum for language arts grades 3-5. Ms. Parisi has worked as a consultant through Rutgers Center for Effective School Practices (2009-2010) and Rutgers Graduate School of Education (2011-2012) providing ongoing professional development for our district in the areas of Writer’s Workshop and Reader’s Workshop for teachers of grades 3-5. She is a certified English teacher and certified elementary teacher.

Rationale:The district will be revising the language arts curriculum for grades 3-5 and creating additional instructional support materials to reflect the instructional changes in language arts at the elementary level.

Cost: \$35 an hour for 450 hours (\$15,750.00) **Account:** 11-000-221-320-04-0000-0

5. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education accept a donation in the amount of \$3,200.00 from the Ravine Drive Elementary School PTO for the purchase of (16) Document Cameras to continue to infuse technology into the curriculum. These cameras are used by each homeroom teacher.

6. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education accept a donation in the amount of \$2,600.00 from Ravine Drive Elementary School PTO for the purchase of (4) iPads and accessories. The iPads will be used in the first grade classrooms for use in Literacy and Math Centers, as well as instruction in Reading, Math, Social Studies and Science.

7. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education accept a donation in the amount of \$3,000.00 from Princeton University. The Princeton University Distinguished Secondary School Teacher Award was given to Dr. Daniel Kaplan, Matawan Regional High School. The recipient’s school receives a \$3,000.00 donation for the purchase of library books.

8. The Superintendent recommends that the Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Board of Education approve submitting the Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB) Grant to the Department of Education in the amount of \$109,566.00.

Rationale:It is important that we make every effort to receive some of this funding to support the HIB mandate.
