Board President Mr. Kenny called the Committee of the Whole Workshop Meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

V. PUBLIC COMMENTS RELATING TO BOARD AGENDA ITEMS

Various Aberdeen and Matawan residents made comments, expressed concern, and/or raised questions regarding the following items included in the agenda:

Mr. Kenny stated that the public can speak during two separate portions of the meeting. Will allow the public to speak about anything they want during the first part which is only supposed to be for agenda items.

Mr. Kenny reviewed the rules for speaking.

Mr. Green, Matawan,

- Expressed concern about the basketball program that has made a lot of progress. Believes if Mr. Stead is not back as basketball coach the students on the team won't have an opportunity to improve during the off season. Mr. Kenny stated the situation is awkward because the Board can not speak about individual employees but the Board is aware of what has transpired and will discuss it with Dr. O'Malley and Mr. Glastein.
- Hopes the Board will reevaluate its decision.

Mr. Kosmyna, 1 Central Avenue, Old Bridge,

Stated the staff member involved did say this could be discussed in public. Mr.
Kenny noted it can not be discussed in public because he has not received the
appropriate notification.

Mr. Weldon, Avalon Lane, Aberdeen,

 Asked that the Board reconsider its decision about the boys' varsity basketball coach.

Mr. Branigan,

- Emailed the Board and thanked some for getting back to him. Does not understand the process about the hiring or firing of an employee. Believes Mr. Stead has stepped up to the plate for the basketball players and there must be some other event that is causing this. Mr. Kenny stated the Board can not speak about the situation.
- Asked if there would be another time to speak. Mr. Kenny answered that the next meeting is a week from tomorrow at 8PM.
- What is the timeline for hiring the coach because they will need to bridge the time to the feeder program for the basketball team. Dr. O'Malley stated the decisions will be made within the next week.
- Doesn't make sense that the Board is not aware of all the details in this situation. Would like to make sure the entire Board is aware.

Mr. Jean,

- Is a former player of coach Stead. Asked if the Board has made a decision on Coach Stead yet. Mr. Kenny stated the Board's function is as policy implementers. Unfortunately, individual Board members don't hire or fire employees in the District. The Board can not answer questions about specific individuals.
- Will the Board publicly give the reasons why coach Stead is not being rehired.
 Mr. Kenny answered no.

Mr. Dailey,

• Current player of coach Stead. Stated coach Stead has done wonders for this team which qualified for the State tournament. Brought Mr. Kenny a petition signed by the students at the High School.

Mr. Kenny stated the person being spoken about has privacy rights that must be respected.

Mr. Robinson,

Former player who of coach Stead as well. Stated coach Stead helped him as
well as many other kids in the community. He makes sure his players keep their
grades up and it would a mistake to let him go.

Mr. Frankfort, Matawan,

 Coach Stead is just not a coach, but like a big brother to his players. Has done some research and has only heard good things about him. To let him go would be a dishonor.

Mr. Weldon, 52 Avalon Lane, Aberdeen

• Also a current player on the basketball team. Stated coach Stead has done a good job of turning around the program and if he's back they will continue to do well.

Mr. Nappi, Line Road, Aberdeen,

 Current player of coach Stead who said he has been helped out by him. Would like the Board to keep him.

Mr. Jones, Cliffwood Beach,

 The fact that everyone is here on a basketball matter means coach Stead is doing something good because this is a football town. Getting rid of coach Stead would screw up the program. Mr. Shephard, Cliffwood Beach,

• Is a volunteer for the basketball program. It will not be in the best interest of the District to let coach Stead go. Hopes he will still be the coach when his kids reach the High School.

Ms. Nappi, 401 Line Road, Aberdeen,

• Turned her son from a boy to a young man. The turnout at the meeting shows the respect that people have for this man. Would like the Board to listen to everyone who is supporting coach Stead.

Ms. Phillip, 8 Oak Lane, Matawan,

 Her son's life is basketball. All the money in this town goes to Mr. Martucci and the football program. The parents are trying to help the players and the program much like coach Stead had done. He has put a lot of time and effort turning the program around. Hopes the Board reconsiders its decision.

Mr. Leo, Matawan,

• Is a volunteer on coach Stead's staff and came to the meeting in support of him. There's nobody who cares more about his players than coach Stead who treats them as if they are his family. Hopes the Board takes the words spoken about coach Stead into consideration.

Mr. Mariniella, 500 Lloyd Road, Aberdeen,

- Noted that the extracurricular positions are not the agenda, however the staffing array is. Asked if the extracurricular positions are posted to which Dr. O'Malley answered yes.
- Asked if the all the extracurricular items will be on the agenda. Dr. O'Malley stated the athletic portion will be there.

Mr. Ruprecht inquired about the procedure for hiring individuals for the athletic positions. Mr. Glastein reviewed the process with the Board.

Mr. Kenny stated Dr. O'Malley had a discussion with Mr. Stead. Mr. Kenny will not discuss the situation until he is assured Mr. Stead knows his rights.

The meeting was briefly adjourned at 7:42 PM so Mr. Kenny could discuss with Mr. Stead his rights.

The meeting reconvened at 7:51 PM as Mr. Kenny stated that he, Dr. O'Malley, Mr. Kosmyna and Mr. Stead met to discuss the options available. Mr. Kenny noted that Mr. Stead will not be waiving his rights.

Mr. Marsh, Cliffwood,

• Stated that a small group of parent complaints often led to the firing of a coach or teacher. Would like the Board, Superintendent and the Administration to let the silent majority to be heard.

Ms. Nappi, 401 Line Road, Aberdeen

Wanted to know when the public could be heard on this matter again and if it
would be before the Board votes at the next meeting. Mr. Kenny stated that most
likely the coaches will be on agenda and members of the public can be heard
prior to the Board's vote.

Mr. Frankfurt, Matawan,

Questioned the timeline of coaches being evaluated and then rehired. Mr.
Glastein stated the evaluation was usually done right after the season. Mr. Kenny
noted that with the terrible budget cuts the District had to make, decisions on
hiring had to wait to see if the funds will still be available. Dr. O'Malley stated
he had a discussion with coach Stead about his situation which doesn't
necessarily happen with all coaches.

Mr. Ruprecht, asked if all positions are posted and interviews held. Dr. O'Malley stated Mr. Stead was interviewed but his situation is unique.

Ms. Nappi, Line Road,

 Questioned if Mr. Stead is not being rehired for monetary reasons. Mr. Kenny clarified that with the budget cuts, some positions may not be maintained.

Ms. Rubino stated that the Board has not met about this situation and is not aware what it's about.

Mr. Warren stated the Board of Education does not choose who the coaches are. The Board's only prerogative is to approve or deny their appointment.

• Mr. Kenny thanked everyone for coming including the students. This is a continuing part of the education process.

Mr. Kosmyna, 1 Central Avenue, Old Bridge,

- Disappointed that the current administration isn't using the process used in the past for rehiring employees.
- Inquired why the Board would hire a staff member for a position that can be handled by another member of the clerical staff.
- Questioned whether the individuals being hired for reading recovery had the proper certification in those areas. Those employees need to continually update their certifications. Dr. O'Malley answered the reading recovery specialists will

continue to maintain certification while those who do not will be involved with basic skills.

 When will the staffing array indicate the amount of time each staff member will spend in a particular building? Dr. O'Malley stated it should be settled by Friday.

Mr. Mariniella, Lloyd Road, Aberdeen,

• Wanted to know the number of teachers that were cut. Dr. O'Malley clarified that some teachers were cut while others retired. The actual number of teaching positions eliminated was 27.

VI. ACTION ITEM - PERSONNEL

A motion by Ms. Esposito, seconded by Ms. Hayward.

There were several comments and questions from the Board.

Mr. Warren asked about the turnover within the science department and how the current hiring process differed from the previous year. Mr. Glastein stated the District instituted Applitrak which provided much more information to the administration such as their college and professional development. There was also a greater pool of applicants due to teacher layoffs around the State.

Dr. Delaney asked if the librarians had been restored. Dr. O'Malley stated they have been restored and will be hiring another one at the High School.

Ms. Demarest asked when the Board will discuss an administrator who will be receiving tenure. Dr. O'Malley stated the Board did have the discussion in April and can provide them with a copy of the list of employees who will be receiving tenure.

Ms. Esposito inquired about the O/T and P/T appointments. Dr. O'Malley stated the administration is still researching their options.

Dr. O'Malley clarified that contracted employees such has himself, Mr. Glastein and Ms. Irons were not part of the original tenure list.

VII. PROGRAM

Dr. O'Malley reviewed the program agenda.

- First item is travel.
- Donations by the PTOs at Cliffwood and Ravine for a Promethean and White Boards. Mr. Kenny praised the efforts of the PTOs and students with their fundraising.
- The rates for Bayada Nurses remained the same for next year. They are used when nurses are on trips and there are no substitutes available.
- Item #3 is the approval of the textbook/novel adoption. Ms. Deluca read the novel and it was recommended by the English teachers at the High School.

Mr. Ruprecht asked if the 8th graders get any preparation for the novel since it is heavy material. Dr. O'Malley stated they receive a little less background about the subject matter.

Ms. Esposito inquired about Bayada nurses and when they are used. Dr. O'Malley stated they are the third option if a substitute nurse isn't available.

Item #4 proposes transitioning a higher math at the Middle School. It provides a
Pre-Algebra in two levels for accelerated and non-accelerated. This will allow
for the condensing of the Pre-Algebra and Algebra courses into one class.

Ms. Demarest asked about the percentage of students in each level. Dr. O'Malley stated there will be more students in 8th grade geometry than the District has ever had. The District will need to revamp the Math program for the later grades as students move to a higher level of Math.

Dr. Delaney asked about the flexibility among the Math levels. Dr. O'Malley stated that students can go into various levels of Math.

- Item #5 is the athletic schedules for next year.
- Item C-1 is for the extended school year which will move to Strathmore instead of Cambridge because Bayshore's movers not coming until the 28th. The rooms will need to be cleaned thoroughly.

Ms. Hayward asked the extended school year at Strathmore goes up to the 5th grade. Dr. O'Malley stated it was and that anything that was going to be held at Cambridge Park will be moved to Strathmore.

• Item C-2 is for the Out of District placements.

Ms. Hayward inquired if the lists were continuing placements to which Dr. O'Malley answered yes.

Ms. Demarest asked if the schedule of athletic events is subject to change since events held in previous years may not be held next year. Dr. O'Malley stated would have to agree with that assessment since changes may need to be made based on other Athletic Directors. Our District is one of 28 Districts to cut golf.

Ms. Demarest stated our District seems to be cutting the least.
