**VI. BOARD PRESIDENT’S REPORT**

Mr. Kenny spoke about several topics.

- Stated it was great to see everyone at the Board meeting during the summer.
- Introduced Mr. Rubin, the new Board attorney.
- At the lasting meeting, part of the action taken was Board policies necessary for QSAC. A lot of work took place. Policies are bones on which the district runs. Board has been emailed policies to save paper.
- Dr. Gambino is proceeding with the Mission and Vision statements along with detailing the round table discussion minutes.
- Mr. O’Connell is working on setting the goals for the District.

Ms. Hayward spoke about the Summer School Program:

- Recognized Ms. Cacopardo who is running the Summer School Program
- The program is held at the Middle School and enrolls 159 students including special education students.
- A detailed breakdown of students who enrolled, attended and completed summer school was handed out to the Board. This also included the grades served and teachers involved.

- One highlight of the program includes the smaller class sizes.
- Another important change is that the curriculum was written by the teachers. In the past had used a workbook program. Teachers could address areas of weakness and for special educations students based on their individual IEPs.
- Increase in attendance monitoring and safety issues were addressed.
- There was an infusion of technology.
- The new life skills classroom was utilized at the Middle School.
- Parents were encouraged to speak with teachers and/or administrators if there was a problem, to open the lines of communication.
- One problem with the program was that there were no computers in some areas which was corrected by Kevin Dugal within 48 hours.

## **VII. SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT**

Dr. O’Malley made several comments:

- Summer school went very well. Credited Mr. Spells as well for running the Summer school Program.
- The schools will be fully staffed when the year begins.
- Schools are being cleaned over the summer.
- Summer packets should be received by August 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Curriculum writing is progressing over the summer.
- Enrollment is on pace with what the administration expected
