If we had to hire a new superintendent (and I hope we don't), what do you look for in a leader?

What are the challenges children are faced with in the world we live in today?

Hypothetical Situation:

We are down to our last \$2,500 and the Superintendent has forwarded 3 proposed uses for the funds. The speech and debate club asks for \$2,500 to pay for a trip for 20 students to participate in a regional competition in Washington D.C., requiring an overnight stay (The team usually finishes in the top half of all

competitors). The football team has asked for \$2,500 to pay for a guest coach to train the team to reduce injuries on the field (There have been a high number of ankle sprains and one break recently). Finally, the teacher of AP Mandarin, with 10 students in her class says she needs \$2,500 to purchase a computer based character reading program to help increase the pass rate the AP test (last year only 1 student passed). The Superintendent gave it to us without a formal recommendation, The board only has \$2,500—How do you go about making your decision, what do you decide and why?

If you could change anything in the district, what would it be? This could be for the better or worse or just different?
