# 1) University of the Aftermarket Foundation Scholarship - \$10,000 - 80 Awards (Deadline: Mar. 31, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior.
- B) Planning to be a full-time student in one of the following disciplines: Automotive, Heavy Duty, or Collision Repair School.

# 2) Bold.org Community Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be 16 years of age or older and in good academic standing.
- B) Be enrolled in a public, private, or parochial high school or home study program in the United States.

#### 3) Lockheed Martin STEM Scholarship - \$10,000 - 200 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a High School senior with a 2.5 or above GPA.
- B) Be enrolling in one of the following majors: Aerospace Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or Physics.

# 4) Herbert Lehman Scholarship - \$12,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior and demonstrate financial need.
- B) Have a combined family income of \$65,000 or less.
- C) Show academic achievement and commitment to public service.

## 5) Educational Theatre Association Scholarships - \$2,000 - 8 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a graduating high school senior.
- B) Be currently participating in Theatre or Film in school or the community.

## 7) KC R. Sandidge Photography Scholarship - \$1,001 – 1 Award (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school student with an interest in pursuing photography.
- B) Submit a collection of 3-5 images from your photography portfolio that relate to one another in a way that is entirely up to you. Editing is allowed if the integrity of the subjects photographed is maintained.

## 8) Project Yellow Light Scholarships - \$8,000 - 6 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently in high school or college.
- B) Be attending a College or University in the Fall of 2022.

#### 9) Frame My Future Scholarship - \$6,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Must be a legal U.S. resident who will be a full-time student at a U.S. college or university in the fall.
- B) Submit an original creation (ie. photography, ink, collage, painting, mixed media, or graphic design work) expressing what you hope to achieve in your personal and professional life after college.

# 10) American Nuclear Society Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior who has enrolled full-time in college courses pursuing science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) with an interest in working in nuclear science and technology.

## 11) JMJ Phillip Group College Scholarships - \$1,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled in a high school or college. Students graduating from high school must plan to attend college during the fall semester in the same year as the application.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 3.6. Current (unofficial) transcripts must be sent with the application.

# 12) Blitman Scholarship to Promote Diversity in Engineering - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: April 1, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior who is a member of an underrepresented ethnic minority in the field of engineering: African-American, Hispanic, Native American, or Pacific Islander.
- B) Have been accepted into an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university.

#### 13) Intertech Foundation STEM Scholarship - \$2,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: April 15, 2022)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.3 or higher with an intent to study computer science.
- B) Be graduating high school in the spring and enrolling at or accepted to an accredited college or university within the US by the end of August 2022.
