

Accessing My TSI Score Report(s)

Need to see your scores? Need to send to your score to your college? Here is what you need to know!


Instructions

1. Go to the ACCUPLACER student portal. It says ACCUPLACER but the TSI and the ACCUPLACER are the same thing! This is the direct link to the student portal:

2. You'll need to provide your name, date of birth, student ID, and where you took the test (United States, TX and then for "Student Institution" Aledo ISD is a choice on the drop-down menu!) **PLEASE NOTE: YOUR AISD STUDENT ID# is not what you tested under!** We test all students under their Texas Student Data System Number! So, you must locate this ID# in Ascender. Here's how:

- a. Log into the Student or Parent Portal in Ascender
- b. Choose "Grades"
- c. Then choose "Texas Assessment."
- d. Your TSDS# is directly under the student's name.

3. Submit your information and click "Send Reports."

You will be sent a link to view and print your test results to the email address you provided when you took your ACCUPLACER test.

4. Check your email.

Once you receive your score report(s) you can send them to your college/university, etc. If you don't see an email with your ACCUPLACER score report, make sure you're checking the same email address you filled out in the demographic section when you took the test. If you still can't find your score report, contact the school where you took the test.
