

College credit decision is the decision to accept or decline your college credit. If you earn a grade of D- or above in the college course, you have two credit decision options:

### ACCEPT LETTER GRADE

Final letter grade will appear on a University of Texas at Austin (UT Austin) transcript.

### DECLINE CREDIT

You will not have a UT Austin transcript.

#### Make your decision during the credit decision period.

The credit decision period occurs after your college grade is finalized and displayed in the OnRamps Portal. Based on your district's course pacing, your credit decision period will be one of the following weeks:

- **May 8** through **May 12**
- **May 15** through **May 19**
- **May 22** through **May 26**

#### Check your inbox!

You will receive an email from OnRamps ([no-reply@onramps.utexas.edu](mailto:no-reply@onramps.utexas.edu)) when your final grade is available and your credit decision period begins. These emails are sent on a rolling basis to the email address in your OnRamps Portal profile as grades are released, so your classmates may receive their notification before or after you.

#### View your final grade and make your credit decision in the OnRamps Portal.

1. Visit the [OnRamps Portal](#).
2. Click *My Enrollments* and select *Current Enrollments*.
3. View your final grade. Then click the *Accept/Decline Credit* button next to the course enrollment and make your decision to accept or decline credit. Save your decision.

#### A credit decision default will occur if you do not make a decision.

If you do not make a college credit decision, the following defaults take place. You cannot change your credit decision after the deadline.

FINAL GRADE	DEFAULT DECISION	TRANSCRIPT ISSUED?
C- or higher	Accept credit	Yes
D-, D, D+	Decline credit	No

### Information about **accepting credit**:

- Most OnRamps courses fulfill core curriculum requirements at UT Austin if the grade is a C- or above.
- Core curriculum courses are guaranteed to transfer to other public universities in Texas if the grade is a C- or above.
- The grade factors into the GPA at UT Austin; other universities may or may not factor in the grade.

### Information about **declining credit**:

- No grade will be reported to the UT Austin Registrar, and you will not have a college transcript.

### Information about **not earning credit**:

- No action is required.
- No grade will be reported to the UT Austin Registrar, and you will not have a college transcript.

### Information about **transcripts and enrollment documents**:

- The UT Austin Registrar fulfills transcript requests. If you earn and accept credit, you will receive an email notification when your UT Austin transcript is available, with instructions for ordering a transcript from the UT Austin Registrar.
- If you do not earn credit or decline credit, you may request a letter of non-enrollment by completing the [OnRamps Letter Request Form](#). OnRamps will provide a non-enrollment letter to colleges rather than a transcript.

## IMPORTANT TRANSFER CREDIT INFORMATION

Each college has its own policies about transfer credit, such as whether transfer credit is factored into the GPA or how credit applies to specific degree plans.

We encourage you to research credit transfer policies at any college or university you may attend before making a decision.
