## **OnRamps Transcript FAQ**

Students who earn and accept college credit in an OnRamps course may request a transcript from UT Austin's <u>Office of the Registrar, Transcript Services</u>, and have it sent to their chosen higher education institution. Students will not automatically receive a transcript.

Students **must** wait until the final course grade is recorded with the Office of the Registrar before ordering a transcript. Students may use the Registrar's <u>See My</u> <u>Grades</u> application to confirm their course grade is posted to their UT Austin transcript.

OnRamps students may use the <u>online transcript ordering system</u> for the **three years** following the end of their course.
