BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b)1, that the 2019-2020 school year budget includes the use of Banked Cap in the amount of \$167,213. The Banked Cap is to help support the following costs: \$85,753 for the increase in Out-of-District Special Education Tuition costs, \$62,000 for the hiring of a full time paraprofessional trained in Applied Behavioral Analysis to serve as support in the newly created multiple disabilities resource program (benefit eligible), and \$19,460 for the purchase of chromebooks and assistive technologies for students with disabilities and reading difficulties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the needs identified in the use of Banked Cap must be completed by the end of the budget year and will not be deferred or incrementally completed over a longer period of time.
