During meetings held remotely for some or all participants, a member of the public wishing to provide comments during public comment on agenda items or public comments on all other items, is directed to type his or her name, address, and group affiliation, if any, in the "chat" window at the start of the public comment section where he or she wishes to be recognized. The Board President will recognize each member of the public individually when it is his or her turn to speak and will unmute his or her audio at that time. If a member of the public wants to provide a comment, but cannot access the "chat" he or she can verbally state their name, address, and group affiliation, if any, and the Board President will inform him or her when it is his or her turn to comment. The Board will also read written comments submitted in accordance with the Board's resolution. All public comments are limited to three minutes, including time for the Board to respond. At all other times, members of the public will be muted. The Board will follow its adopted bylaws, procedures, and resolutions with regard to conduct during the Board meeting, including during public comments.

VI. WORK SESSION TOPICS

a. Discussion regarding reopening priorities

Nurse Polifroni will receive all of the Covid testing results before the school building opens again on January 11th.

b. COVID update and vaccine discussion

The BOE discussed the state roll out of the vaccine and the availability of electronically registering to get on the list to receive the vaccine. Dr. Hughes is going to schedule meetings of the Pandemic Response Team for this next phase of preparedness. The goal is to allow the middle school students more time in the building for in-person learning.

c. 9th grade student placement

Dr. Hughes did a presentation on the 9th grade placement process. The previous placement process has been reviewed, and the teachers will recommend student high school placement with the oversight of the Administrative team. It was recommended that Dr. Hughes schedule a Coffee with the Superintendent session regarding this topic.

d. Emergency Plan

The schools current emergency plan includes addendums referencing the procedures during a pandemic. It was reapproved at the reorganization portion of the public meeting.

K. Bevilacqua - 376 Maple Street: Asked if the middle school will be moving to Standard Based Report Cards as well? She also inquired if Demarest and Closter would also use Standard Based Report Cards since they also send students to Northern Valley Demarest High School?

Dr. Hughes - responded that Standard Based Report Cards for middle school students are currently being worked on. He noted that Demarest and Closter both use a report card model that is in between the traditional model report card and a standards based report card model. He also noted that the Northern Valley Curriculum Center is aware of the future changes and feels it is fine for placement.
