NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Haworth Board of Education hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2022-2023 Tentative Budget in the sum of \$15,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
