

SCHOOL RULES

On Bicycles, Skateboards, Scooters, & Hoverboards

Students are welcome to ride bicycles, skateboards, scooters, or hoverboards to school if they abide by the following rules:

- Wear a helmet and have it buckled as required by state law. The administration will confiscate a student's bike/skateboard/scooter if he or she doesn't wear a helmet and keep it in the office until the student produces a helmet.
- Lock your bike/scooter and put it inside the bicycle rack before school begins.
- Stay away from the bicycle rack except when parking and picking up your bicycle.
- Lock your bike/scooter individually, not to another student's.
- Lock your skateboard/hoverboard in your locker immediately upon entering the building and do not remove it from the locker until dismissal.
- DO NOT ride your skateboard/hoverboard anywhere in the building. Any student caught riding their skateboard/hoverboard in the building will have the item confiscated and kept in the office until a parent comes to retrieve it.
- WHEN ON CAMPUS WITH A BIKE/SKATEBOARD/SCOOTER/HOVERBOARD, YOU MUST WALK IT AT ALL TIMES; THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS.
