## What is the PSAT/NMSQT?

- PSAT/NMSQT is designed to help students gain exposure and practice to a test similar to the SAT.
- The questions are all multiple-choice format and assess the students' ability in math, reading, and writing.
- If a high score is received, students may be eligible to become a National Merit Scholar and earn scholarships for college

- Taking the PSAT/NMSQT offers practice with timing, types of questions, and testing environment you may see on an actual SAT.
- Students may qualify for scholarship money/recongnitions.
- Colleges may recruit students.
