**AGREED INJUNCTION**

ON THIS DAY, the Court considered Plaintiff the State of Texas’s request of injunctive relief enjoining the above-named Defendants from violating the Texas Education Code and Texas Election Code. Without admitting that they violated any law and in an effort to settle this dispute, the Defendants do not object to the State’s Petition being **GRANTED**.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED** that Defendants, their officers, and agents of the Aledo Independent School District shall not use any funds or resources of Aledo Independent School District, including e-mail, or other means to engage in electioneering in violation of Texas

Education Code sections 11.169 and 45.105 and Texas Election Code sections 255.003(a) and 255.0031(a).

This Order shall be effective without the execution and filing of a bond. Pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code section 6.001 the State of Texas is exempt from filing a bond, thus, it is **ORDERED** that no bond be paid by the Plaintiff.

It is ordered that the Clerk of the Court issue a writ of injunction to Defendants in accordance with the terms of this Order. All parties shall be responsible for their own costs and no attorneys fees shall be assessed in this matter.
