

AZC Meeting Minutes- January 26, 2021

All members of the AZC introduced themselves.

Trent Smith from Templeton Demographics presented the most current demographic report for Aledo ISD.

- Reviewed the process of Templeton Demographics to project district enrollment by using student geo-code, housing markets, cohort and enrollment trends, and district planning areas
- Displayed the local districts and how they compared with their enrollment projections
- Presented a snapshot of the demographics of AISD and the growth of Texas schools across the state as well as the growth of Region 10 and 11
- Provided housing market trends for Aledo ISD including housing sales, new construction, closings compared to the area and compared by district subdivision, active and future subdivision development
- Examined specific neighborhoods that are expected to grow substantially over the next several years and in which attendance zones the most growth and potential growth is occurring currently
- Displayed the projected new homes over the next 5 years and where those new homes would currently attend school
- Forecasted enrollment by grade level for the next 10 years
