Application Process and Checklist

OVERVIEW:

At Mid-Pacific, we provide a personalized admissions process and approach that recognizes the unique qualities and experiences of each applicant. Throughout the process, we provide opportunities for the applicant and family to express their individuality through personal statements, assessments, and interactions that provide a holistic understanding of each applicant and family. Because we value the partnership between school and family, we encourage you to take advantage of every opportunity to get to know Mid-Pacific, our educational approaches, and our mission and values.

AGE ELIGIBILITY:

To be considered for admission for the school year 2025-2026:

- All applicants must be three (Preschool 3) or four (Preschool 4) years old by July 31, 2025.

REQUIRED STEPS:

- Create an online [myPueo](#) account.

DUE NOVEMBER 1:

- Complete an application form and submit a \$125 non-refundable application fee.

DUE JANUARY 31:

- Complete the Preschool (PS) Parent/Family Information Form**
The perspective provided by parents/guardians is highly valued. The PS Parent/Family Information Form is an opportunity for parents/guardians to provide information about the unique qualities of the applicant, family, and interest in Mid-Pacific.
- Attend a Preschool Information Session (Parents/Guardians Only)**
After your application form and fee have been submitted, register for an on-campus Preschool Information Session through the myPueo Checklist. These sessions are held in November and December. This is an opportunity to learn about Mid-Pacific's Reggio-Emilia inspired program.
- Attend a Play and Observation Session (with applicant)**
After the application form and fee have been submitted, applicants can schedule a preschool play and observation session through the myPueo Checklist. These 30-minute group sessions are scheduled on a Saturday during December and January. One parent/guardian will be allowed to accompany the applicant into the classroom during the observation session. Please contact the Admissions Office if residing off-island for a virtual option.
- Attend a Parent/Guardian Virtual Follow-up Meeting (Parents/Guardians Only)**
A 20-minute virtual parent/guardian follow-up meeting will be scheduled after the applicant has completed the play and observation session. This is an opportunity for parents/guardians to receive feedback from the play and observation session.

OPTIONAL RECOMMENDED STEPS:

- Attend Open House - October 19, 2024**
- Schedule a campus tour** (by appointment only)
- Upload Preschool video** Provide a 2-minute video of the applicant at play or doing an activity of interest.

FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS ONLY:

- Upload Passport**
Upload a copy of the biographic data page of the applicant's passport, which includes their legal name, birthdate, and photo.
- Upload Visa (if applicable)** Upload a copy of the applicant's visa or Green Card (if applicable). If not issued yet, please indicate what type of visa they will have upon enrollment in the International Supplement Form.
- Complete the International Supplement Form** The International Supplement Form allows parents/guardians to provide information about the applicant's anticipated immigration status and living arrangements upon enrollment.
