TITLE: Approve the Manteca Unified School District Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Funding Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2023-24

Background/Rationale:

On November 8, 2022, California voters approved Proposition 28: The Arts and Music in Schools Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act. The measure required the state to establish a new, ongoing program supporting arts instruction in schools beginning in Fiscal Year 2023-24. The amount of funding available each fiscal year for the Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) program will be one percent of the K-12 portion of the Proposition 98 funding guarantee provided in the prior fiscal year, excluding funding appropriated for the AMS program. The content of the AMS program is included in Chapter 5.1 Part 6 of Division 1 of Title 1 of the Education Code (Section 8820 et seq.)

Pursuant to California Education Code Section 8820(g)(4), local educational agencies (LEAs) that receive AMS program funding must submit an annual board- or body-approved report to the California Department of Education which shall be posted on the LEA's internet website. The annual report details the type of arts education programs funded by the program, the number of full-time equivalent teachers, classified personnel, and teaching aides, the number of pupils served, and the number of school sites providing arts education programs with these funds. Attached for review and consideration of approval by the Board of Education is the Manteca Unified School District Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Funding Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2023-24.
