

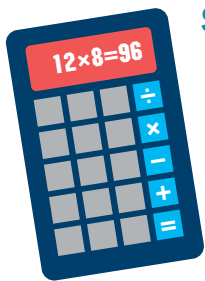

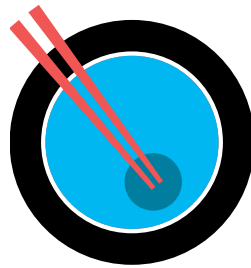
Supporting our students' needs is a top priority at The International School of San Francisco. In addition to **robust financial support for tuition** which enables continuing enrollment, we understand that the full benefit of an education at our school entails more than just attending academic classes. To that end we offer financial assistance within our amazing **Global Travel Program**, enabling all students to participate regardless of their means. To support students' academic endeavors we have a **Device Support Program** which offsets the costs of acquiring a computer in High School.

Furthermore, we recognize that there are other areas of school life that are very important. We have a comprehensive support program (SUCCEED) which addresses other areas of school life. SUCCEED is aimed at providing supplemental support for families on the highest levels of financial aid. The program provides support in the following areas::



SCHOLASTIC EQUIPMENT:

Support for scholastic equipment purchases such as calculators or standardized testing materials



SUPPLEMENTAL LUNCH ASSISTANCE:

Students' families are provided a grocery vendor gift card each month to support provisions at home (i.e. traditional bagged lunch). Additionally, SUCCEED students have access to gift cards for an occasional lunch at community food vendors within Hayes Valley such as La Boulangerie, Patxi's Pizza, Dragon Eats, and RT Rotisserie. (*Vendors subject to change each year.*)



ATHLETIC GEAR & EQUIPMENT:

Support for required sporting gear and equipment related to High School athletics



STUDENT ACTIVITIES & EVENTS:

Support for attending school spirit and social events: prom, winter formal, etc.

Students are eligible for support in the SUCCEED Program if they meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Students receiving financial aid whose aid grant is 90% or greater
- Students whose financial contributions, in addition to our financial aid package, are paid by programs such as Making Waves, SMART, ABC Scholars, KIPP, etc.
- Students in the foster care system
- Students with a documented (with the school's counseling staff) extraordinary family situation
