BYLAWS & REGULATIONS

MISSION

To teach and perfect the skill and tradition of cornhole to students, along with the honor, respect, sportsmanship, and loyalty the game instills in its players.

The cornhole court is sacred ground in which the great competition among friends is embraced.

The WAHICC is reserved for distinguished individuals who agree to represent the characteristics of cornhole, but who also wish to have fun with peers who share the same motivation for improvement.

ELIGIBILITY

Any student at Walla Walla High School is eligible to join, so long as they follow all the rules of the club and respect the game of cornhole.

To compete in club competitions or tournaments you must show up to practice often and express interest in competing to the Scheduling Cardinal.

INDIVIDUAL FEES

Each member has the option of providing their own bags however, these bags must be approved by the American Cornhole League, American Cornhole Association, or American Cornhole Organization. (approved bags may be found on their websites)

Custom jerseys may be purchased and worn.

CONDUCT

Each member must always show respect towards other members.

Each member must show good sportsmanship during, before, and after any game.

Playful joking about results or performance is allowed but insulting is not tolerated.

Drinks are allowed but must be able to be closed if drinking while playing.

Worn ball cap style hats must be turned around while playing.

No open toed shoes may be worn while playing.

All official cornhole league rules must be followed during play. (see cornhole tournament rules)

Each member must obey any staff advisors and club leadership.

LEADERSHIP

Along with staff advisors the WAHICC is run by the student Cornhole Clergy. The Clergy is run by the Cornhole Pope, similar to a club president, and supported by multiple Cornhole Cardinals.

The Pope resides in command over the club but under staff advisors.

Cardinals fill the roles of Scheduling, Public Affairs, Recruiting, and Security officers, along with other roles that may be added.

Each year a new Clergy for the WAHICC will be appointed by the current sitting members of the Clergy.

Cardinals may be chosen for Pope the next year, but a Pope may not sit on the Clergy in following years.

In cases of incompetence, non-compliance, or negligence in a Clergy member's duties, the rest of the Clergy may hold a vote to replace the member. The vote must reach a majority vote with the rest of the Cardinals, then be approved by the Pope.

AMENDMENTS

Any member of the club may challenge a rule by speaking to staff advisors of the Clergy.

Any amendments to club bylaws and rules will need a Clergy majority vote and Pope approval, or staff advisor approval.
