Look up fun facts about the dam, for example the dam is 660 feet thick at its base. Now go outside and mark a starting point and take 660 steps, look back to your starting line. WOW!! <b>Science</b>	<p><b>Activity Description</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lightning Bugs</li></ul> <p><b>Directions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go outside and catch some fireflies. If you have a container to keep them in, put them in it without harming them. Observe the fireflies and what they look like. Make a scientific drawing of the fireflies. Label the parts of the firefly.</li><li>• Facts about fireflies<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Fireflies are really beetles because they have four wings; true flies only have two wings.</li><li>○ Most fireflies like warm, humid areas.</li></ul></li></ul>

- In the United States, glowing fireflies are found east of the middle of Kansas.
- Firefly larvae feed mostly on earthworms, snails, and slugs.
- Have fun and release the fireflies that you were able to catch when you are done!!!!
