The goal of the Seabury Scholarships is to enable non-traditional students to undertake college or vocational studies who might otherwise be unable to do so. We have therefore designated these scholarships to be awarded for one academic year for non-traditional students whose education has been interrupted and who have clear education and career goals. Students must re-apply for the Seabury Foundation Scholarship if they wish to be considered for the following academic year after they have been initially awarded.

The requirements and qualifications for this scholarship are:

- 1. Must be a degree seeking, non-traditional student with clear educational and career goals.
- 2. Enrolled in at least 6 credit hours in the fall or spring and/or a minimum of 3 credit hours in the summer.
- 3. Must achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA and complete 66 percent of your attempted hours to receive second semester funding.
- 4. Complete the FAFSA (free application for federal student aid)
- 5. Complete the application for admission and be pre-enrolled.
