

If a teacher is keeping the same teaching assignment as the previous school year, the teacher may copy the previous year's SLO

As always, teachers will be provided with instruction on how to access the archived SLO and copy it into this year's Strive web platform.



# Establishing a New SLO

Any teacher may construct a new SLO at their discretion; however, a teacher who is teaching a different subject or grade level than the previous year must create a new SLO.

A new SLO must be constructed using the Texas SLO PDF Form.

Once created, the SLO must be transferred into Eduphoria, and the SLO form must be scanned and uploaded as evidence in Strive.

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## Use the SLO Success Criteria

#### **SLO Success Criteria**

This tool is designed to be used by appraisers as they review SLOs for approval. Ideally, SLOs will demonstrate effectiveness with each of the success criteria. Appraisers can use this tool to coach teachers for improvement throughout the SLO process. In addition, teachers are encouraged to use this tool as a guide to improve the quality while crafting each aspect of the SLO process.

#### SLO Skill Statement

- 1) Represents a foundational skill that is specific to the content area
- 2) Persists throughout the course
- 3) Measurable through a demonstration of student skill
- Focus on it will lead to student and teacher growth in this course and beyond
- 5) The skills captured are clearly defined and appropriately focused, and aligned to the standards for the course

#### Initial Skill Profile

- 1) Articulates skills for the beginning of the year
- Differentiates between skill levels
- Descriptors align to skill statement (potentially through subskills)
- 4) Can be assessed in multiple ways
- Based on multiple sources of evidence and a teacher's experience

#### **Targeted Skill Profile**

- Articulates skills for the end of the year
- Differentiates between skill levels
- Descriptors align to skill statement
- 4) Can be assessed in multiple ways
- 5) Targets are specific to the students in the teacher's class and based on multiple sources of evidence
- Reflects high, yet reasonable, expectations for student growth



Texas provides teachers and administrators with a checklist for evaluating and setting minimum expectations for each component of the SLO.

All components of the SLO must meet the criteria set forth

by TEA.

#### Student Learning Objective

#### TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS: UPLOADING EVIDENCE

You will follow these steps when uploading any type of Evidence into the Eduphoria/Strive System

#### FOR YEAR-LONG COURSES (August thru May)

You will upload <u>1 to 2 pieces of Evidence</u> for every student that you are tracking in your Student Portfolio at each data point (milestone) listed below.

You can scan all evidence into one file and upload that one file at each data point (milestone).

The following are the required upload deadlines for the 2024-2025 school year:

- . ISP Evidence Upload by October 4, 2024
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Six Weeks Progress Check Evidence Upload by November 8, 2024
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Six Weeks Progress Check Evidence Upload by December 20, 2024
- 4<sup>th</sup> Six Weeks Progress Check Evidence Upload by February 26, 2025
- 5<sup>th</sup> Six Weeks Progress Check Evidence Upload by March 28, 2025

#### **FOR Semester COURSES**

(August thru December & January thru May)

You will upload <u>1 piece</u> of evidence for the ISP and <u>2 pieces</u> of evidence for each progress check.

The following are the required upload deadlines for the 2024-2025 school year:

#### 1st Semester

ISP (1st Six Weeks) - Upload by October 4, 2024 (1 piece of Evidence)

1st Progress Check (2nd Six Weeks) - Upload by November 8, 2024 (2 Pieces of Evidence)

2<sup>nd</sup> Progress Check (3<sup>rd</sup> Six Weeks) - Upload by December 13, 2024 (2 Pieces of Evidence)

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester

ISP (4th Six Weeks - Progress Report) - Upload by January 24, 2025 (1 piece of Evidence)

1st Progress Check (4th Six Weeks) - Upload by Upload by February 26, 2025 (2 Pieces of Evidence)

2<sup>nd</sup> Progress Check (5<sup>th</sup> Six Weeks) – Upload by March 28, 2025 (2 Pieces of Evidence)



- As soon as the teacher sets the ISP Rating (baseline@1st six-weeks), the teacher needs to immediately set the TSP Rating (target) at the same time.
- Warning: teachers who do not set the TSP Rating (target) for each student at the beginning of the process will skew their final data.








# REMINDER: Required Milestones in Aware Student Portfolio (Full Year Courses)

These milestones should be created at the beginning of the year and should appear in the following order in the student portfolio:





- Initial Skill Profile (ISP)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Six Weeks PC
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Six Weeks PC
- 4<sup>th</sup> Six-weeks PC
- 5<sup>th</sup> Six-Weeks PC
- Targeted Skill Profile (TSP)
- EOY Rating



# Required Milestones in Eduphoria Student Portfolio (Semester Courses)

Semester courses will only create one SLO for both the fall and spring courses. In addition, only one student portfolio will be constructed as well. This is due to an update made by Eduphoria that teachers will find helpful.

This one portfolio will be used for both the fall and spring! As always, specific instructions will be made available.
