## MT. ZION FIELDHOUSE RULES

- The Fieldhouse track and courts are available for use by people residing in the Mt. Zion School District. Children in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and below must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- All patrons must have a Fieldhouse pass to use the facilities. Passes may be picked up during regular school hours at any Mt. Zion school or at the Central Office by filling out a pass request form, signing a waiver, providing proper identification, and proof of insurance.
- Only Adult Residents are able to bring guest(s) with them. Daily guest
  passes may be purchased at all Mt. Zion schools and the Central Office for
  \$5 with proof of insurance. All guest will be required to sign a waiver at
  the Mt. Zion Fieldhouse. Guest passes must be turned in to the
  supervisor to gain entry.
- All patrons must use the west entrance to enter.
- All patrons must show an ID and their Fieldhouse pass and sign in to be admitted.
- No food or drinks other than water allowed in the fieldhouse.
- No track spikes allowed.
- Restrooms in the Lobby are available for public use.
- Locker rooms are not available for public use.
- During community use you may play basketball and walk or run on the track only. <u>The use of batons, hover boards, baseballs, softballs, and</u> footballs is not allowed.
- All patrons must bring their own equipment. All equipment must be approved by the supervisor on duty. No outside shoes allowed.
- Sharing of courts No full court games if people are waiting.
- Patrons engaging in a fight, unsportsmanlike conduct, or using inappropriate language will be asked to leave the facility immediately and subject to their pass being suspended for a period of time set by the fieldhouse supervisor.
- All school rules apply.
- Mt. Zion School District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
