

Mt. Zion School District Summer School High School Credit/Credit Recovery Courses

June 3 - June 28, 2024

Mt. Zion School District is pleased to offer in-person high school coursework that will allow students to earn $\frac{1}{4}$ unit of credit for Consumer Education and Driver Education or $\frac{1}{2}$ unit recovery credit for high school English, Math, or Science. Out-of-District students are welcome based on availability. All building and room assignments will be provided when each course is confirmed to families. All course offerings may be subject to minimum enrollment requirements with a full refund for classes not held. *Please note: there will be no classes held June 19, 2024 in observance of the Illinois Juneteenth Holiday.*

Consumer Ed & Driver Ed attendees please note: due to conflicts with the Junior High Eighth Grade Trip, classes will begin **May 29**. **There will be no Consumer Ed or Driver Ed classes held June 3 - 7**. These classes will resume, Monday June 10 and will finish no later than Friday, June 28.

Course Description for High School Course Offerings:

Driver Education Classroom Studies – This course fulfills the classroom component of the driver's education program. The aim of the class is to enable students to develop sound judgments and proper mental attitudes for the safe operation of a motor vehicle. Each student must attend at least 30 clock hours of classroom instruction and complete all required coursework and assignments to earn a passing grade for this phase of the driver education program. This course does not include behind-the-wheel instruction. Arrangements for behind-the-wheel instruction must be made with the high school of the student's home district. Student must be 15 years-old on or before August 08, 2024 to enroll. Earns $\frac{1}{4}$ credit unit.*

Consumer Education – Students will learn the techniques of budgeting, check writing, consumer credit, insurance, and costs of owning and operating a car. Each student must attend at least 30 clock hours of classroom instruction and successfully complete all required coursework and assignments to earn $\frac{1}{4}$ credit unit.*

English Survey – This credit recovery course is designed for students needing $\frac{1}{2}$ credit of high school English. This is an excellent opportunity for students who have not successfully completed the English requirement to earn credit towards graduation. Each student must attend 60 clock hours of classroom instruction and successfully complete all required coursework and assignments to earn $\frac{1}{2}$ credit unit.

Credit Recovery Math, Science – This credit recovery offering provides an excellent opportunity for students to earn up to $\frac{1}{2}$ high school credit towards graduation. Course participation and completion is contract-based. Students must fulfill all requirements of the contract and online course work to earn credit. APEX Learning must be used in the classroom with an instructor. Course options include: **Pre-Algebra; Algebra 1; Algebra 2; Geometry; Biological/Physical Science.**
