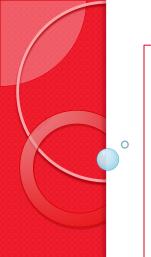

Impact of a Contingency Budget

- Based on the laws of 2012-13, the contingency tax levy for 2014-15 must be the same as the 2013-14 levy of \$69,109,469, which equates to a \$0 tax levy increase.
- Spending reductions to meet the contingency budget tax levy requirement must be \$647,397.
- Cuts necessary to meet this reduction may include programs below and more:
 - Reduction of the district's full day kindergarten program
 - Reduction of our athletic program
 - Reduction of non-contingent expenses such as technology, other equipment and certain supplies
 & materials

What does a tax levy at 0.94% mean for our taxpayers?

• "Eligible Taxpayers" (with annual incomes at or less than \$500,000) will qualify for a tax credit if their school district's 2014 budget did not exceed the tax cap. In October 2014, this tax credit will be sent by check in an amount equal to the applicable increase in school taxes from 2013 to 2014
